THE MESSAGE OF THIS MINISTRY

Jesus Christ has presented all men and women with a divine Overseer for their lives; His shed blood creating a bridge to spiritual communion with the Father. Jesus came to set human souls free from their own futile attempts to find power, possessions, and peace. He came to give mankind a better choice, the choice to live our lives with the power of His love.

The apostle Matthew wrote that Jesus said He was giving the Keys of the Kingdom to His followers, saying, ***“Whatsoever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatsoever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven”*** (Matthew 16:19).

This does not mean that God has to bind and loose in heaven whatever we have bound and loosed on earth. Rather, these keys are our means of coming into Kingdom agreement on earth with God’s already established purposes in heaven. In the Lord’s Prayer (Matthew 6:10; Luke 11:2), Jesus declared agreement with God’s purposes as He prayed, ***“Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”*** In our prayers, we can declare agreement that God’s will on earth shall be done in alignment with His already established will in heaven.

Many Hebrew and Greek words for “bind” and “binding” have such positive meanings—tie, put oneself under obligation to, weave together, heal, undergird, hold, persuade, and cause fragmented pieces to coalesce and become one whole again.

The word “loose” in the original Greek, (*luo, hegnum, agnumi*) mean untie, break up, destroy, dissolve, melt, put off, wreck, crack to sunder by separation of the parts, shatter into minute fragments, disrupt, lacerate, convulse with spasms, and tear up.

In prayer, we can bind our wills to the will of God, our minds to the mind of Christ, and ourselves to the fullness of the truth of His Word. We can put ourselves under obligation to God. I really like the idea of having a scriptural/spiritual power key to use in prayer when I need to put my sometimes unruly will under obligation to God’s will!

Loosing is a powerful prayer key for cutting the ties to the clutter your unsundered soul still clings to. This prayer key can rid you of present clutter and prevent reattachments of former clutter (old bondages, bad

attitudes, etc.). It will clear out the old junk your mind loves to feed on and the grave clothes your soul tries to drape you with.

Loosing prayers also wreak havoc with and cause spiritual terrorism on evil spirits, and loosing prayers destroy stronghold-opened doors that the enemy accesses to harass you. Jesus said that He was giving the keys of the Kingdom to the Church and that whatsoever believers would bind/loose on earth was bound/loosed in heaven.

These keys can dismantle everything that has allowed the unsundered souls of believers to sink down deep roots of fear and pain out of traumatic memories. This dismantling is accomplished by loosing the denial, the defenses, and the deceptions that have kept God’s grace and mercy out of these deep, dark hiding places within us—so He could heal us.

TARRYING TIME WITH THE LORD

I recently took my first vacation in 15 years. This retreat time in the woods revealed to me what a fast track I had been running upon. Sometimes you don’t realize what you are doing until you are forced to stop. When I got up the first morning in my cabin and realized there **were no personal phones, cell phone signals, internet hook-up ability, or e-mails,** I felt totally strange. I was alone in a cabin in the woods with God!

I went through serious electronic withdrawal the first day, and I realized how many things interrupt true tarrying with God. I began to research the word **tarry**. I found that while tarry does mean “to wait,” it also means “to prefer.” Tarrying with the Lord means to prefer His company over all other interests or activities, spiritual or non-spiritual.

Back at LSM, we all began to work on our tarrying skills. And, just as someone who carries something is a carrier, we have decided that someone who carries must be a tarrier. Upon saying that word aloud, we began to laugh and talk about being good tarriers. I may write a message one day that asks the burning question: ***Are You a Good Tarrier? (woof***

WE'RE ENLARGING OUR "TENT" AGAIN FOR OUR T-CERTS

We have torn out walls, remodeled, and revised our Teachers' Certification Training to fit a new, intense, four-day schedule right in our own Center. The smaller classes allows more individualized teaching.

REFINING YOUR PRAYER PRINCIPLES

Healing is a gift from God that can require life change in the soul and/or changes in the physical habits of one who needs healing. Healing is not something to bind yourself to. You need to pray and loose wrong patterns of thinking about illness and disease. You need to disrupt, shatter, and destroy wrong agreements that certain diseases are inevitable because of your family lineage.

Peace is a gift from Jesus that can require the loosing of peace-destroying habits that our souls love—worrying, scheming, discouraging thought patterns, etc. Peace is not something to bind yourself to to receive this gift, you

need to give up (loose) feeding your mind with negative things thought patterns. As you do this, **you make room for peace in your soul**. That is where you need it—in your soul! Your born-again spirit already has peace that passes all understanding!

Right choices come from knowing God's will and doing it. Right choices don't happen by binding yourself to them. Right choices becomes clear as you bind your will to God's will, your mind to the mind of Christ, and your soul to the truth of the Word—carefully reading the Word to know what it says the truth is! This positions you to make right choices and know that God will empower you to walk them out.

Good behavior comes from experiencing right choices. Good behavior does not happen because you pray and bind yourself to it. Good behavior comes from making right choices and experiencing the consequences of them. You must be familiar with the Word of God in order to know what the right choices are. Loosing wrong thought patterns about wrong behaviors will definitely help.

Patience comes only from experiencing waiting and enduring the wait. Patience does not come by binding yourself to it. Patience can only be acquired through the experience of waiting, even enduring. You cannot bind yourself to height, weight loss, or maturity. These things are acquired through life experience. Remember that:

*And finally—binding and loosing prayers do not eliminate our need to change--
THEY MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR US TO CHANGE!*

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question: I'm having real difficulty in forgiving myself for past wrongs I've done to others, which have really hurt them. I've tried looking in your books, but can't find such a prayer. I'm really tormented by this and struggling to believe God could forgive me. This has been going on for a long time. Please help. Missy

Answer: Missy, Stop looking for a specific prayer and begin paying as many of the prayers in *SYS* and *BTP* as you can get yourself to pray, specifically the Breaking Soul Power prayer on page 30 in *BTP*. You have far more issues in your unsundered soul than the one you mention, we all do. Consider this analogy. You are trying to find a way to "heal a sore on your foot" that is only a symptom of "a hidden infection in your whole body." You don't need a "sore foot" prayer, you need "body, soul, and spirit" prayers. You are trying to focus on fixing a symptom when you should be praying all of the prayers you can to open up to God so He is free to heal your soul.

Question: I always ask myself and others how to hear the voice of God. I know His word says that His sheep know His voice, and it worries me that I may not be hearing His voice. Can I truly hear the voice of God?

Answer: Do you know the voice of your mother or your father, of your best friend when you hear it? Of course you do—because you have spent time listening to them. You will know the voice of the Father when you spend time in the Word, in prayer, and waiting upon Him.

If what you hear causes you to want to change, to want to surrender, or to become Christ's servant for His purposes, it probably was Him. If what you hear appeals to you because you might become a great prophet or a great spiritual leader, having words for many, you might question Him a few times to see if it really was Him.

Question: Rev. Savard, my husband has left me and set up another home. It really hurts when he comes back to our house and takes things to furnish his new house. I feel enraged when he just walks in and ignores my feelings about boundaries right now. I feel powerless. I have asked God to forgive me for these feelings. My husband actually asked if I would pack the rest of his things up for him! Help me understand, Sharon

Answer: Sharon, I strongly suggest that you pray to break all soul ties with your husband. This almost always reduces pain in your own soul in situations like this. Soul ties are not a healthy means of keeping an emotional contact with any other person. The Breaking of Soul Ties prayer and an entire chapter on soul power and soul ties are in *Breaking the Power*.

The general binding and loosing prayers (*Shattering Your Strongholds*) will help strip away the clouds and confusion in your soul so that you can receive direction and guidance from God. There is no telling what "old unresolved issues" of your life that your soul is bouncing off of right now.

The prayers and the information in all three of my books are not designed to change what is happening, but they are designed to help you process everything that is happening in a scriptural manner with God's help to get healed and become whole. **You will begin to work more smoothly with God if you set new boundaries to stop the short-circuiting of your soul right now.**

Listen very carefully here, and then pray about what I am going to say. Then, **unless God says NO**, begin to clear out some of the stress you are undergoing. First of all, you said your husband has moved out and set up a new home. If he were still in your home trying to work things out, that would be different. But he has chosen to establish a new home for himself for the time being.

If this is true, then go ahead and pack up whatever is his along with whatever joint possessions you feel he might need. **Have them delivered to some place where he can pick them up, and then change your locks.** Tell him that you need some space to begin working with God to become whole. **Let your answering machine answer all of your calls.** Begin to spend time alone with God, knowing that your husband cannot come across the new physically-enacted boundaries at **your home** that you have set up for the time being.

Such boundaries, set to give you some breathing and healing room because you are in emotional distress, do not mean you are not willing to work things out according to God's direction. They only mean that you need to clear some space to allow God to work in you so you can think clearly and hear His direction.

Many rejected wives are afraid to give themselves this space with God because they think as long as they keep some physical tie with the husband, **no matter how emotionally difficult it may be for them**, there may be a hope. You have all the hope in the world for God's will to be done here. God often works better when there is no in-the-natural-realm-reactions causing the emotions to spike and plummet between two human souls.

For now, hold tight to God. Set genuine boundaries in the natural realm of your life, and let God be God. God can work with your husband without your presence in the middle of it. Let me know how you are doing.

Question: I have so much trouble with depression. Where does depression come from?

Answer; The soul that learns to try to hide its stress “underground,” burying its toxic waste of unforgiveness, bitterness, and hopelessness, telegraphs its distress to the body. Medical experts have found that the body reacts by pumping toxic chemicals into our blood streams. Medical scientists have proven that this is what happens when we try to bury unforgiveness, bitterness, etc.

This creates a chemical imbalance in our body that can cause depression, and so much more—even lethal diseases like cancer. This is the product of the soul’s dangerous coping mechanisms of stuffing, burying, and denying. The only answer is to get God into the areas of our souls that need to be healed or destressed. The function of the prayers in these books is not to change the circumstances of our lives, rather to change how we respond to them.

Paul the Apostle said that “*Abraham believed God and it was accounted to him as righteousness.*” The phrase “Abraham believed God” (in the original Greek) means that Abraham was in agreement with God’s will in his every thought, purpose and action (soul, spirit, and body). Abraham was considered to be righteous because of being in alignment with the will of God in every aspect of his being. In Isaiah we read that the fruit of righteousness is PEACE.

I battle depression at times, too, which I believe is compounded by pressure against this ministry. When I have no peace, I know I am out of alignment—somewhere—with God’s will for my life. This lack of alignment is almost always causing hidden stressing in my soul. The resulting toxic chemicals being released pull my body chemistry out of balance—not only giving opportunity for depression, but also compromising my entire immune system.

I believe the answer is to constantly maintain our souls with focused binding and loosing prayers. These prayers not only have the power to bring us to a place where we can receive the peace Jesus has for us, they also have the power to stop further compromising of our entire immune system. That is a huge benefit I am currently researching!

Question: Because of a sin of more than five years ago, I cannot forgive myself. I used to pray the prayers in *SYS*, but I can’t anymore. This thing seems so much bigger than me, I have lost the faith I once had and I am severely depressed. How can I be forgiven?

Answer: You need to start praying the binding and loosing prayers again. Your soul is hassling and harassing

you big time. The enemy is just piggy backing on it. Let me ask you a few questions.

Did you publicly deny that you know Christ? Peter did, and he believed he was forgiven and went on to fulfill a great destiny.

Did you commit adultery and have your sexual partner’s spouse murdered? David did, and he believed God forgave and restored him to relationship with Him.

Did you murder or torture Christians? Paul did, and he believed he was loved and forgiven.

These things are written in the Bible to show us the magnitude of God’s love and forgiveness towards the failings of His children. When you cannot forgive yourself, are you not saying that your standards for who is worthy of forgiveness are higher than His?

He will forgive you, but then He wants you to believe it is over. This is where the prayers are very helpful. They break your soul’s recycling of the guilt. Ongoing guilt is never from God! Please go back to praying the prayers to make room to receive God’s mercy, grace, love, and healing. He wants you to get on with good things!

Question: I think I may have a soul tie with someone I guess you could call an “unrequited love” from years ago in my past. Do you think there is still an unhealthy tie here because I still think about him sometimes? How many times should I have to pray the Breaking Soul Ties prayer in *BTP* to get free from any fantasizing about what might have been if I’d married him?

Answer: Soul ties are formed when a wrong agreement in entered into that seems to hold a mutual benefit for both parties. Sometimes that mutual benefit is on that both parties’ might have some of their unmet needs met, or might feel that some of their unhealed hurts would be understood and respected. Other times, the mutual benefits are for having control, and a feeling of safety from being “controlled. Depending on how important the soul tie was to you and to the other person, you may have to pray that prayer continually for awhile to make sure the tie is permanently severed. When you think of him, you may be feeling insecure from something that has retriggered unmet needs or feelings of insecurity. This may be causing your thoughts to return to the deceptive fantasy that he could have met all of your unmet needs.

Some soul ties are severed with a one time praying. In other cases, one or both souls may keep trying to figure out a way to reconnect them. This “breaking and severing” is not really a healing or an act of God. Is it an

action you have chosen to reject and refuse your own deceptive fantasies and any reconnection of the soul tie from the other person's deceptive fantasies.

Sometimes we come into wrong agreement with others when our souls feel alone and unable to "belong," or when there is an intense need to have someone care. You must break away some of the layers of self-protective, deception, and denial that your wounded soul has formed over its most vulnerable areas, God will not force His way into them to heal you. And, still hurting and fantasizing, your soul will just keep seeking ways to find its own answers.

TESTIMONY: This is a long over due thanks for your counsel, prayers, and the love that you showed to me last year regarding a group I was facilitating about the teaching on the "inner-child." I was in confusion as to whether or not it was scriptural. Your counsel was and is truly from the Lord. Based upon what you offered for my consideration and prayer, I explained to my group that I felt that this teaching does NOT line up with Scripture and I had to be accountable to the Lord for my beliefs. Everyone respected my honesty, and we went on to complete other subjects in the class with good results. That is how we teach people to pray regarding tissue invasive diseases, binding the cells to the will of God, and loosing (smashing, tearing apart, dissolving) the reproductive ability of any foreign, alien, mutated cells in peoples' bodies) so that God's destiny purposes for their lives would be fulfilled).

July of 2000, I went on a bus ride reluctantly, not knowing that God was going to answer prayer that I cried out to him asking for help and understanding. Question: I have an urgent prayer request. My son Wendell, who is 20, wants to get married to a girl who is pregnant by someone else. Answer: We will pray for Wendell, for this girl, and for you. Much grace and mercy is needed here, and God's will should be considered first. Please hear me carefully here, Wendell did not get "caught up" into a sexual relationship with this girl. He made a personal choice to do so. He may be struggling with that fact and trying to do something his souls says will make it right. This can make those who him seem like they are opposing his attempts at righting things. You will need a lot of wisdom to minister to him. You should also be praying for this

young woman, and the unborn baby. You might be the only one who is.
