A WORD FROM LIBERTY

In early 2003, my 83-year-old father became very ill and went into the intensive care unit of a local hospital. My 82-year-old mother went into the same hospital a few days later and then they both were moved into a skilled nursing home. On May 12th, my father died and I preached his funeral on May 15th. He had declared that Jesus Christ was His Savior and Lord.

My mother remained in the skilled nursing home with early dementia, high blood pressure, congestive heart failure, and advanced diabetes. I drove 400 miles round trip every week to spend 2 or 3 days with her. In God's grace, my speaking engagements for 2003 were very few and I had no immediate writing deadlines. The Lord kept my schedule geared towards my parents the whole year, while my staff picked up the slack and did a great job of keeping the ministry going forth from the LSM office in Sacramento.

I was sure that if I just planned carefully enough and worked hard enough, I could do it all. I could make everything work for everyone. I even thought I could or should be able to make my mother do what the doctors wanted her to do.

After all, doesn't the Bible say, "I can do all things through Christ Jesus"?

The LSM Partners prayed for me, my ministry peers talked with me. My staff, close friends, and son and daughter-in-law were supportive. But even with this support, it was amazing how guilt would sweep over me when I couldn't make things work right. But the binding and loosing prayers kept that guilt from burying me.

I read the Word every day, prayed a lot, and drove a lot. My car, Blessing, could almost drive that 400 miles by herself.

About August of 2003, I had begun to work on launching the LSM Correspondence Course Studies of the message I have written about and taught for nearly 18 years. People had been asking for correspondence studies for some time. When Rev. Karen Failor in Fort Wayne IN offered to put together the technical side of the graphics and the compact disks for the studies, I felt things were coming back together.

Then in the third week of October, while on a visit to my mother, I was home alone when I awoke at 3:00 a.m. with horrible abdominal pains. I called an advice nurse who said, "Hang up and call 911!" An ambulance came and I found myself in agonizing pain in the same hospital where my parents had been. I had acute pancreatitis and gallstones. For the next 12 hours, I was on such high doses of pain medication that I didn't even realize I was going to be airlifted back to Sacramento for surgery.

As I recuperated from the surgery in November, I asked God why I had pancreatitis and a gallstone attack so far away from home. I felt that God said I needed to understand that there would be times in my carefully administrated and scheduled life when I could not always control things—even my mother's health and care. **He said that I needed to learn that He was most in control when I was completely out of control.**

My mother had continued to resist everyone's attempts (especially mine!) to get her to follow through on physical therapy, elevating her legs (she had diabetic sores), and other things that would have improved her health. But even in that, God was still in control. She accepted the Lord in September. Then in the last week of November, my mother's nurse called me in Sacramento and said that I should head north for Redding right away. She said my mom was having "difficulties." Five minutes later, the nurse called me back and said my mother was gone.

My mother gone? I went into shock and kept trying to convince the nurse that this couldn't be because they had just called me and said she was having "difficulties." I kept telling them that I had to be with her if she was going to die. Nobody had said she would be gone in five minutes!

I went into my "ministry mode" and pulled together her funeral, preaching the service on December 3rd. For the rest of the month, I stayed in Redding and my aunt and I went through all of my parents' possessions and records, preparing a closing of her estate. My aunt, Mildred Boone, was a big help to me at this time. Together we

Found many amazing hidden treasures, like silver jewelry in a plastic bag in the back of the freezer.

During this time, I apologized to my mother almost daily as I prepared to give away or sell a possession of my parents that no one else in the family could use and I simply could not take home with me.

Now I am finally back home and the remaining physical evidence of my parents lives are in boxes in my garage. Never again will I be able to try to convince my father that ministry and writing books are legitimate “jobs.” Never again can I call my mom and tell her about trips across the country or around the world that made her feel like she was part of my travels. But I know where they are and that I will see them again.

In all honesty, 2003 was a year of surviving pain, grief, and struggles and learning from them. 2004 is the year of victory that comes after such a year of spiritual and emotional testing, learning more of His goodness, and turning it into something useful for helping others. God is good and He has been completely faithful.

This ministry’s message (the Unsundered Soul and the Keys of the Kingdom binding and loosing prayers) has once again proved itself completely sufficient to keep me close to Him while going through hard, hard times. For every hard thing I faced, a brief time of deep breathing, gratitude to God, and binding and loosing prayers always helped me to continue. I was quite amazed at what I found I could actually do. In January I looked at a prophetic website that I check about every three months. There I read a good word, a word for those who are ready to accept divine changes in their lives and then abandon themselves to God in 2004.

Beloved, I am fine-tuning every aspect of your life if you will allow it. Even your relationship with Me will come to a higher and more effective level as you let Me show you what must be changed. You will first see these changes manifest in your natural life, for the natural will come first and then the spiritual. Do not resist change brought about by My Spirit, but by the same token, do not initiate change for the sake of change or out of boredom. Be sensitive to your spiritual environment, and be willing to move with the Wind of the Spirit.

I have shut doors behind you and opened doors before you. Truly there is a door standing open, waiting for you to walk through. It is not an opening that is obscure and elusive, nor is it something that you will miss if you continue to seek My face and walk the path that I have chosen for you. Have no fear that you will miss My

purposes for you. I will give you ample opportunities to make course corrections even when you take a wrong turn, for surely I will be your guide when you cannot see what is ahead, I will direct your steps, and I will give you wisdom to accomplish what I have set you to do.

As I have moved forward in this new year, I have continued to pray and ask God to make me very sensitive to His course corrections in my life in all of 2004.

I hold the ministry office of the teacher, and I am committed to helping and training others to embrace their callings, especially those called to be teachers of His Word. I am particularly committed to helping people cut through their souls’ inner static so they might hear God personally directing their lives. While apostles and prophets speak inspired words from God for an overview for the Body of Christ, sort of like a spiritual map showing the way to God’s divine restaurant—it is the teacher who tenderizes and broils the meat, cooks the potatoes, makes the salad, and then gives the believer the knife and fork needed to eat it.

Paul says in Hebrews 5:12-14, in The Message, “By this time you ought to be teachers yourselves, yet here I find you need someone to sit down with you and go over the basics on God again, starting from square one—baby’s milk, when you should have been on solid food long ago! Milk is for beginners, inexperienced in God’s ways; solid food is for the mature, who have some practice in telling right from wrong.”

Too often we let our unsundered souls sort through all the voices they are listening to today in order to determine whether or not we are recognizing right from wrong. The world is throbbing with voices—“voices” on television, the radio, in the newspapers, in magazines, and on the internet demanding that we try it all and have it all or be a loser. Publishers print thousands of new books every year. Junk mail fills our mail boxes, and SPAM clogs our e-mail addresses. We are so numb to this bombardment of words against our minds, we don’t realize how hard it is for God’s words to get through to us.

Plain and simple, we are listening to too many voices!

Believers are even seeking more words from other believers in the Church. I am often contacted by people who have had a prophetic “word” spoken to them and they want me to tell them whether or not it was God. I have had people send me tapes of multiple prophecies, asking me to clarify or confirm which words are for them. These people are also listening to too many voices, when they should just be still and listen for God’s Spirit to clarify their understanding.

God rarely speaks to us when we are running here and there in hectic activity, and He never speaks different words through several different people creating a maze of words we have to move through like a rat after a piece of cheese. God never tests you in a manner to confuse you. He waits for quiet times to encourage you, to guide you, and to assure you of His power and love. In this world of voices all vying against other voices, we must never become numbed to the Spirit's voice within us.

Listening to God is an acquired skill. You hear from God in your born-again spirit, but your unsundered soul can either block what your spirit has received (the soul does this with strongholds), or it may reprocess and revise the information so that it lines up with what your soul has already chosen to believe. This can create quite a problem for those who are not learned in God's ways, and especially for those who do not know how to recognize and reject ungodly counsel and advice.

Job's friends were so wrong when they assumed that they needed to show Job why he had lost everything. They buried him in their words. God probably intended that they try to help Job hear from God. This is the role of the teacher, to instruct others in such a manner that they can learn to hear God themselves. I could speak thousands of correct and true words to you and still not help you if your soul is filled with strongholds that prevent you from receiving God's truth. But if I instead help you understand how to dismantle your soul's strongholds that are confusing and clouding your ability to hear Him, then one simple word or phrase from God can break through into your heart (your soul) and change your life in marvelous ways.

I believe God is speaking to each one of us about dynamic, radical change in 2004. I know many are very tired of the ordinary and are seeking for the extraordinary, or for—if I might dare to say it—the supernatural side of being a Christian! The Lord has set open doors before us, and He has prepared unbelievable opportunities and unexpected paths for us to take.

If we are willing to be flexible and moldable—if we are willing to let go of all of our old baggage—He will fine tune us and change our paths so that we walk in ways we have only dreamed of through doors we didn't know existed.

Lord, show us the course corrections we need to make to walk through the doors you have set before us! To cooperate with Him when He does, loose all preconceived soulish ideas and misconceptions you have had about God. Listen to what He is actually saying now, don't just strain to hear if He's saying what you want Him to say. Listening with a clear and unclouded mind, will, and

emotions is a developed discipline. The first step towards that discipline is to get rid of the rubble that is in the way of letting the Holy Spirit rebuild your walls—just like Nehemiah did when he was directing the workmen to rebuild the broken down walls of Jerusalem. This is where understanding the Kingdom Key of loosing can be very powerful.

It is our prayer at LSM that in 2004 you will open yourself up to God and His divine course corrections more than you ever have before. We wish you the very best of God's purposes and plans for your life and we're here to encourage and exhort you to go for His gold.

Different LSM donors donated money for the postage.

THE KIWI (NZ) CONNECTION!

I want to thank all of you who prayed for us while we were in New Zealand for three weeks during March. What an exciting trip we had! The LSM Team consisted of Rev. Liberty Savard, Minister Linda Cady (LSM Staff Administrator and LSM Advanced Teacher), and Dee Kotilainen (LSM Advanced Teacher) from New Mexico. We all flew on separate flights (conflicting personal schedules), and while I was waiting in the New Zealand Airlines VIP lounge in L.A. for my flight, I had the pleasure of chatting with one of the main Oscar winners for the Lord of the Rings movie. There were four Oscar winners on our flight to Auckland.

I arrived in Auckland NZ 13 hours later where I was picked up by the Life Impact Team members, Brenda Parshotom and Steve Farrelly. After an overnight rest to get our "ducks all rounded back up," the LSM team and the Life Impact team flew to Rotorua, home of active thermal pools. We were told that much of New Zealand is on top of volcanic activity. Dee played golf on a course with a Moiri name (I can't even spell it) that means Hot Mud Plopping Softly. She said that this was exactly what was going on with the thermal pools scattered around the course. Wouldn't want to lose a ball in one of those!

We had a wonderful turnout for the conference in Rotorua, with some unbelievable testimonies. One woman attending the conference had been in a mental institution with a diagnosis of no hope of ever being released. A friend of hers began to pray the binding and loosing prayers from *Shattering Your Strongholds* for her, and the doctors said they saw a difference in her behavior within a week. Gradually the friend got the woman to pray the

prayers with her, even reading parts of the book, and God did a miracle of healing in her mind! The totally healed woman gave me her testimony personally, along with the confirmation of the friend who was with her. She had come to the conference to tell me thank you and let me know that she was studying to be a counselor.

In a couple of days we flew on to Christchurch where we had another great conference and I was privileged to speak on Sunday morning at a wonderful church. I regret that I do not have the names of all of the churches and people we were with in NZ, but my laptop just self-destructed and I have not been able to reclaim some of the information that was on it. But God knows the people and the churches who were so kind and generous to us.

We had a great time at the McCafe specialty coffee bars in many of the McDonalds in New Zealand. American McDonalds people, are you listening??? I ate my first Kiwi burger there—a typical Big Mac with the addition of a slice of pickled beet and a fried egg. It was actually very good. I will also say that Kiwi restaurants make the best French fries I have ever eaten anywhere in the world, hands down. I also tasted abalone burgers in New Zealand. I'm not too sure about them, I must admit. Perhaps it was the fact that they were blue and green that gave me pause even before the first bite. But one big swallow of a Vanilla Latte at the McCafe coffee bar and all was well again. The Kiwis love their specialty coffees.

Minister Linda Cady spoke to a group of children's Sunday School teachers in Christchurch and later attended a special prayer meeting for their upcoming children's camp. In that same church, I later learned that the man on the sound board during one of my services was also one of the Lord of the Rings Oscar winners! God was gracing us with many exciting little surprises.

We flew on to Wilmington and Upper Hutt where I was thrilled to be invited to the New Zealand House of Parliament to meet with some wonderful people. I had really felt that God might give me an opportunity to meet New Zealand's Prime Minister, Helen Clark, because I had become so interested in her leadership from reading the New Zealand newspapers. No Prime Minister turned up, but our conference in Upper Hutt proved as exciting as the previous ones.

Then we all flew down to Dunedin on the South Island where the meetings were superb and the people were very open. Brenda Parshotom, Director of Life Impact, and Steve Farrelly, Life Impact Conference Director, were wonderful hosts. We enjoyed dinner one night at a local Japanese restaurant in Dunedin. I was tickled that I, an American, had to go to New Zealand to go to my first Japanese restaurant.

As we were waiting in the Air New Zealand VIP Lounge in Dunedin, the Prime Minister of New Zealand, Helen Clark, came into the lounge to await an airplane meeting with Prince Andrew from England. I was thrilled to have an opportunity to speak privately with her, one on one, assuring her of our prayers for her continued leadership of her country. God had so ordered my steps for that divine connection that I was open-mouth amazed, even though He amazes me all the time! You'd think I would be used to it.

We flew back to Auckland where we had started from, holding our final conference at The River Church on Friday and Saturday, and then I spoke at a wonderful Presbyterian church on Sunday for Pastor Andrew. The Kiwis are delightful people with a wry sense of humor. I even learned to speak some Kiwi, telling my audience that I was feeling a bit toey, so I was going to go out in the wopwop and throw a wobbley.

I must admit that my clothes seemed to be slowly shrinking in New Zealand, maybe it was the humidity. Or perhaps it was that the Kiwis have a full-out morning "tea" with goodies galore and a full-out afternoon "tea" with little sandwiches, cakes, and quiches. Yet you rarely see an overweight Kiwi. Perhaps the mystery of the shrinking clothes was due to the fact that we still insisted upon our American schedule of breakfast, lunch, and dinner, and since we did not want to insult our Kiwi hosts—we enjoyed all of their "teas" as well!

Our many thanks to all of our new Kiwi friends and especially to the wonderful Life Impact team for making our ministry in New Zealand so exciting and special. Steve Farrelly told me that we had a total of some 1,300 to 1,400 people at the conferences who were so excited to hear the message that all of our book tables were sold completely out. Please pray for the people of New Zealand that they will not be deterred in moving in this message, especially in using it to continue taking down the territorial spirits over their country that we began loosing from over the five different cities we visited.

When people question me about binding and loosing, I say, "I can tell you this, once the wall was there and now it is gone." Liberty, I have been praying the binding and loosing prayers, along with the Breaking Soul Ties prayer. I asked God why I was still hurting so bad. My mind wouldn't grasp how I could keep holding on to something I didn't want, like you said in your books. I guess because emotions are felt, I can't actually tell when I'm holding on to them.

That night after I cried out to God, I had a dream. I never have dreams, only nightmares. There was a little girl crying as she knelt on one knee, and her other knee was all scraped up and covered with blood and dirt.
