FROM
LIBERTY**

What a great thing to know that we have the Master of the universe (and beyond!) living inside those of us who are His children! We need to remind ourselves of that every day (perhaps several times a day). This is the reason we can have hope in all situations. Hope is the expectation that something good is coming to you.

Faith (in the original manuscripts) means trust and confidence in the goodness, wisdom, power, and love of God towards you. In Romans 15:13 (*Amplified*), we read that Paul prayed this: *“May the God of your hope so fill you with all joy and peace in believing [through the experience of your faith] that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound and be overflowing (bubbling over) with hope.”*

The Apostle Paul never prayed prayers that were unanswerable. He knew that God’s mighty Holy Spirit’s life-giving energy was a promise of overflow and hope that God would be in all of our circumstances. Hope means you can take refuge in and be sheltered within your expectations of God’s goodness.

Hope resides within your soul. I know that many any of you are trying to cause your souls to surrender to God’s will through praying the binding and loosing prayers. But are you aware that this should be an ongoing process?

You need to look at the maintenance of your soul in the same way you look at the maintenance of your body. You feed it good things (I hope); you cause it to rest when it is exhausted (I hope); and you scrub dirt, plaque, and bad smells off it when it is unclean (I really hope!).

When you are determined to hope in God’s goodness and mercy, hope will invade your thought processes and turn around negative thinking. When you are determined to hope, hope can invade your emotions and strengthen your joy and your expectations. When you are determined to hope, hope can infuse your will and cause it to push you towards God’s leading.

If you are not taking authority each day over your own unsundered soul with the binding and loosing prayers, it can get into soulish mischief. When your soul is left to rummage around in its carefully kept files about how badly others have treated you and how God isn’t fair, life can look pretty discouraging from that perspective.

David addressed his own soul when he was disquieted and downcast. In Psalm 42:11 (NKJV), he said, *“Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; for I shall yet praise Him, the help of my countenance and my God.”* He spoke to his soul asking it what right did it think it had to be discouraged. Then he commanded it to get back to hoping in God—praising Him for who He is.

Hebrews 6:18-19 tells us that our hope is in God and His guaranteed promises. These promises are an anchor to our souls. Hoping for His goodness, wisdom, power, and love to always be aimed at you is the anchor you lay hold of when your soul is racing madly about in a state of reactions and distractions.

Genuine hope is not wishful thinking, but a firm assurance that you are a son or a daughter of the most high God. He has your past failures buried in the deepest sea, the reins of your present firmly in His hands, and your future fully planned out and under His full control. All He needs for you to do is surrender your preconceived ideas about what you think He should do, and commit your ways to learning how to agree with His plans and purposes for you.

Set your soul on hope's cruise control today:

- If you have unsaved children, bind them to the will of God and loose the works of the enemy off them. You CAN hope for God's grace to draw them to himself.
- If you have a marriage in trouble, bind yourself and your mate to the will of God and loose the works of the enemy off you and your mate. You CAN hope for God's work of love to be completed in each one of you.
- If you have financial problems, bind your will to the will of God and loose wrong ideas and beliefs you have about money and provision. Know that God's provision is not dependent upon whether or not the enemy gets in the way of it. You CAN hope for a renewing of your mind about finances and hope for a blessing from God.

I have hope right now that the world is opening up to this message like it never has before, and the opportunities to teach it to many have increased tremendously. Let me share a few of these opportunities through the eyes of hope.

BEYOND Shattered Strongholds – Exciting New In-Depth Update of SYS Being Released in July 2005 at CBA in Denver CO

When I attend the Christian Booksellers Association trade show in Denver CO in July, we will be launching a new book called *BEYOND Shattered Strongholds*. When I wrote the original SYS during 1989-1991, I truly believed I was just recording a revelation God gave to me about the Keys of the Kingdom. Some thirteen years since SYS was published in 1992 many aspects of the message have deepened, and I have changed my mind about a couple of interesting issues (but none of the basic doctrine).

It has been very exciting to update the original SYS and

integrate the new information and progressive revelation that has come with teaching the message. If you want a revelation to expand within you, teach it—and it will continue to grow and grow. This new book, **BEYOND Shattered Strongholds**, should be available for shipping by the third week of July. **BEYOND Breaking Soul Power** and **BEYOND The Produced Promise** are also being prepared. Here is a small preview of part of this newest book:

Excerpt from Chapter 1: Keys of the Kingdom

Aren't you grateful that God's wonderful salvation was freely given to you? Don't ever forget that your salvation was a divine gift with no strings attached! However, your freedom and peace of mind as you walk in your salvation does require cooperation on your part. But not to worry! Jesus not only saved us and promised us eternal life with Him—He also provided a way for us to overcome the trials of life right here on earth and be filled with love, peace, joy, and power as we do it. What a Savior!

That provision is the Keys of the Kingdom in Matthew 16:19. Jesus said: ***"I will give you the Keys of the Kingdom, whatsoever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, whatsoever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."***

Jesus left us these supernatural keys to enable us to bring our lives into alignment with God's will in heaven. With these keys, we can release our inner weaknesses, neediness, and pain to Him and then walk in His power, strength, grace, and love wherever He wants us to go. As we pray with these keys, our souls can be flushed free of all old thinking, prejudices, and fears that the world or the devil could tap into to put us in bondage.

If this book could have been wired for sound, there would have been an audio cut of a flushing toilet right here to make sure you get the picture of what loosing can do to the old baggage in your soul!

Christ's giving of these keys in the first part of Matthew 16:19 represent the giving of permission, authority, and ability to enter into the kingdom of heaven to transact spiritual business according to the will of God. The last part of this verse reveals how to transact that spiritual business. We pray with these keys to cause things on earth to come into alignment with all things as they have been established in heaven—just as Jesus prayed in the Lord's Prayer in Luke 11:1-2, KJV:

"And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples. And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father

which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth."

In the Scriptures the word "key" is used figuratively for power; it is also used as a sign of official authority. In Luke 11:52 (KJV), Jesus spoke to the Pharisees about the key of knowledge, ***"Woe unto you, lawyers! for ye have taken away the key of knowledge: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered."*** The Pharisees jealously guarded this key of knowledge of

spiritual things, distorting rather than revealing the truth of God's love and His

life-saving guidance and instructions. They put great burdens upon the Jewish people and prevented them from understanding the truth.

Excerpt from Chapter 2: You Must Know the Truth

You do not "know" the truth by just memorizing it or talking about it. In 2 Corinthians 5:5 (*The Message*), we read, ***"The Spirit of God whets our appetite by giving us a taste of what's ahead."*** God gives us a taste of His truth to cause us to want the whole seven-layer cake of His

goodness! The unsundered soul does not like the taste of anything God puts

forth, let alone the smell. This is because the taste of His goodness is always seasoned with obedience and surrender in order to fully enjoy it.

In the original Greek text, one of the meanings for truth is "having nothing concealed." You have to handle and act upon truth to see what may yet be concealed from your understanding. This doesn't automatically happen by just attending the biggest seminars, viewing the latest videos, and reading the newest books. Wisdom comes from truth discovered and then acted upon—truth experienced. Ephesians 3:19 (*Amplified*), ***"That you may really come to know—practically, through experience for yourselves—the love of Christ, which far surpasses mere knowledge without experience . . ."***

There is nothing wrong with imitating your spiritual elders to enter into new principles and patterns of victory. This is how new Christians often learn about praying, warfare, witnessing, and interacting with other believers. But you will only learn about relationship with God by seeking, interacting with, experiencing His love, and making room within your soul for all of Him.

Always remember that the ultimate goal of the Keys of the Kingdom prayer principles is to make your soul surrender to the will of God. Your unsundered soul

will not change its ways for God's purposes except when it is constantly washed in the Word and forced to pray prayers that obligate it to His will. These prayer keys in themselves are only a means to that end. They must be used faithfully with focus and belief in their power to cut through the residue and rubbish of your past.

You can have great knowledge about how to do something and still be undone if you don't do anything with it. Wisdom comes from the experience of acting upon knowledge. Experience the knowledge of the Keys of the Kingdom and go farther than you've ever gone with God before!

Doesn't Jesus say narrow is the road that leads to life and few are they that find it? I haven't read your trilogy yet, but I intend to now. I (Liberty) have edited this from an article someone sent to me, but I do not know who originally wrote it. Still I felt it was something we need to think about:

“Cling tightly to your faith in Christ, and always keep your conscience clear. For some people have deliberately violated their consciences; as a result, their faith has

been shipwrecked” (1 Timothy 1:19, NLT). If we don’t live the life we believe, we will end up unhappily believing in the life we are living.

In an experiment at the Moody Institute of Science the founder of the Institute wore a pair glasses every day that made everything look upside down. He slept with his eyes covered so he never looked at anything without wearing the glasses. After three weeks his mind converted everything it was perceiving so that things appeared to be right side up!

The mind does a similar thing when we live out of harmony with God’s directives. The person who consistently lies ends up believing his own lies are true. Criminals justify what they have done by telling themselves that the people they victimized deserved it!

When we consistently go against what we know to be right, we get into what is called cognitive dissonance which, simply put, means mental disharmony. Not being able to live with this distress and disharmony, we change our beliefs to match our behavior, rather than the other way around. This is how we rationalize and justify whatever it is we want to do.

When we don’t live the life we believe and know to be right—the life God has revealed to be true—we will end up believing the life our unsundered soul pushes us to lead. We will end up with a dead conscience and a hardened heart.

Questions and Answers

QUESTION: Dear Liberty, I have been reading your book, *The Unsundered Soul*, and it’s enlightening and helping me so much. I’ve been saved since childhood but I’ve never really understood the Lord’s nature. I grew up with an unloving, alcoholic father who never kept his promises and I’ve had a tendency to see the Lord as and uninvolved and unloving as well.

I was divorced seventeen years ago. Around that time a good friend in my church kept telling me that the Lord was saying He had a new mate for me. This was very comforting to me, as I didn’t have happiness in my short marriage. I’ve dated a few people over the years but everyone turned out to abuse me in some way. The Lord has yet to fulfill his promise to me.

ANSWER: Are you sure that having a mate, in the state of pain you are in, is what God has promised to you? I can see from your words that you feel you always get hurt in your relationships. There is a reason for that—you have a wounded and needy soul that gives too much and wants too much. God does not want you hurt again, so while it might be difficult for you to receive, He is protecting you

from another relationship until you are healed and ready to have one.

Here is what I believe that He wants for you: 1) He either wants you to want Him so much that you won’t care if you get married or not. Or, 2) He wants you to want Him so much that He’ll be able to heal you so you can have a balanced, whole relationship with a man some day. Either way, this is a win-win situation, is it not?

QUESTION (cont.): I keep getting older and the years keep passing, and all the while I am NOT happy with the idea of growing old alone. Non-Christians find mates every day. What is the hold up in the spiritual or natural world for me? I’m very attractive and have a lot going for me. I don’t understand.

ANSWER (cont.): Non-Christians get divorced and hurt and betrayed every day as well. Being attractive on the outside and filled with pain on the inside isn’t going to help any relationship you might have. Only in God’s will are you going to ever have a fulfilling, loving relationship with a man after God has healed your soul. There is no man out there right now who is capable of meeting and fixing all your unmet needs, unhealed hurts, and unresolved issues. Nor does any man exist who could live up to and meet your expectations that he should make you feel whole and fulfilled.

Both your soul and the enemy are feeding you deceptions that just keep torching your feelings! I am so sorry that this is happening to you. Your soul has wounds and unmet needs and holes in it. Unfortunately, it is clear that it has determined only a human relationship will fix its pain. If you don’t strip its wrong patterns of thinking, your soul will drive you even deeper into despair. It may even drive you into dangerously wrong relationships.

The issue here is that you need to be whole (or at least partially complete) to be a blessing to a man and to be blessed by a man. No human being can fix your brokenness and take away all your pain, only your Creator can (if you will let Him). As I said above, if you let God work out all of the painful needs, wounds, and unresolved issues in your soul, then if you still want a relationship I believe God will bring you a super mate! You can stop fighting what God wants to do to heal you and cooperate with receiving His grace and mercy by beginning to pray the prayers in *The Unsundered Soul*—praying them with focus and a desire to believe that they are going to work! QUESTION: At our home cell group, we were reading and discussing pages 116-117 in SYS about the cost of forgiveness. You said, “When you forgive, you release the one who is guilty and place yourself in their stead . . .

When you forgive, you are the one (who needs to be willing) to bear the loss instead of the one who caused the wrong. Jesus gave His life to prevent the loss of our lives.”

There was no example of the point you were making. If we are to “bear the loss” instead of the one who caused the problem, are you saying we shouldn’t look to collect anything for someone damaging our car or ourselves (for example).

The other person still has to abide by man’s laws which hold him accountable for the damages, right? Could you address this point with a good example of what you are stating? Russell B. Texas

ANSWER: I’m always glad to try to restate anything that I did not make perfectly clear in my books. The point I wanted to make on page 116-117 of SYS was this: as far as you and me being the ones who have to “pay” the cost when we forgive someone for what they have done—this is the attitude we must adopt and act from We must be willing to be the ones who bear the loss if the other person will not make it right—and we must do it with a pure heart that has forgiven them completely.

I was not trying to say that we cannot accept any restitution from the other person, only that our attitude must be that we are willing to let it go and “pay the cost” ourselves if they don’t recompense us.

All responsible drivers have automobile insurance today. Insurance to some is a way of being protected against loss. To others it is a way of being able to be responsible for damages that exceed their ability to pay. You can forgive others for what they have done and still be in a right attitude of forgiveness when applying for reasonable insurance restitution. This is why all drivers are required (at least in my state) to have insurance—so they can be responsible to someone they have injured or property they have damaged.

BUT, if you were to go to court and wipe out someone financially to recover damages (real or perceived) against yourself, I do believe this is wrong. Receiving restitution in a right manner has to do with the attitude of the heart which has forgiven the deed.

QUESTION: I need help in dealing with a client who has multiple personality disorder. She was in integration therapy for ten years. She thinks that another personality has manifested. LLR, Licensed Counselor

ANSWER: I’m not sure I can be of help to you here, because I don’t really track with the generally accepted

ideas on multiple personalities. I believe in dealing with the unsundered soul as one entity, and that so-called “multiple personalities” are really just subterfuges or facades the wounded soul manifests. So, in dealing with people who appear to be manifesting multiple personalities, I have always ignored the “personalities” and spoken directly to the soul. One of the meanings of the word “bind” is to cause many fragmented pieces to come back into one whole. I just keep binding the person’s soul into one whole, and loosing deception. I am hoping you have read some of my books and know what I’m talking about with binding and loosing prayers.
