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### Meet Sam DaSilva

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Dear Liberty: First, I would like you to know I consider it a privilege to be serving as an LSM Board member. Thank-you for the invitation to be on your team. I look forward to being a part of this pioneering ministry.

As you know, I was first introduced to the principles of binding and loosing through your books over a year ago. Time does not allow me to explain the miraculous way I first received your books here in Ontario Canada. Perhaps I'll put that story in writing at a later date. As a Christian psychotherapist, I was astounded by the depth and breadth of the healing possibilities I was learning from God as I turned the pages of *Breaking The Power* and then from *Shattering Your Strongholds*.

I was not only moved by the concept of loosing and binding, but I was also impressed with the context in which you put it. I found your understanding of the human psyche to be outstanding and refreshing. Your wisdom in this area was impressive considering you had no formal training in the area of psychology. Your grasp of the subject is insightful and comprehensive.

Your books were putting into words much of what I'd believed God had been showing me over the past few years. Although I had participated in deliverance ministry, I began to see a disturbing trend of blaming the devil but not dealing with the unhealed soul. Some things were not adding up. Any suggestion that changing the person from within would actually shove any demonic influence out was met with either anemic agreement or cold hostility. I now realize that in the face of not knowing how to effectively deal with the unhealed soul, chasing demons gave us something to do. It made us feel accomplished.

But that is not why I am writing. I wanted to share something I stumbled upon last June. Excited by the content of your books, I had been implementing the principles of binding and loosing in my therapeutic methods at work. I required my clients to read your

books, and many began to complain of an inability to comprehend them. These were intelligent folks who had no difficulty comprehending other readings. Then it struck me that their unsundered souls were actually resisting their understanding of the books!

After several of these complaints, I was reminded of the "training-wheel prayers" for Breaking Soul Power on page 30 of *Breaking The Power*. So I decided to "guinea pig" that prayer. Instead of recommending that clients read the books, I asked them to first pray this prayer out loud for 7 to 14 days. I was amazed by the results. People were not only able to then read the books, but they absolutely devoured them. I wondered that if 7 to 14 days were that effective, what would 30 to 40 days do for my clients? You guessed it! As part of therapy, I began to ask clients to pray out loud the "page 30" *BTP* training wheel prayer for at least 30 days.

To say I was thrilled with the impact it had would be an understatement. I was not only thrilled, but I was intrigued by certain events that happened as client after client began expressing similar themes. Please note that none of these people knew each other. I had the delight of gathering all these self reports.

Many clients initially prayed for about 7 to 10 days and then, for some reason, forgot. I had expected that some might, but I wasn't prepared for the emotional backlash that each one experienced. When I convinced them to start praying again, discouragement or depression immediately began to lift. One client said, "When I forgot to pray, it was the worst day I had in a long time. Not that bad things happened out there, I just felt bad in here," pointing to her heart.

I was not really prepared for what happened next. Those clients who persisted beyond the 20 to 30 days of praying the *BTP* "page 30" prayer began to experience miraculous changes in areas they had struggled with over long and hard times. One client who had a shopping addiction, among other chronic symptoms, reported that shopping no longer had the same attraction or effect it once had over her. Someone else, who had always struggled with a strong need for approval, became aware that the need had simply disappeared. We hadn't even begun to address this issue in therapy yet. God was meeting these people in remarkable ways!

I could write story after story of people experiencing changes bringing new freedoms into their lives. Whole general outlooks were being transformed. The *BTP* "page 30" prayer was powerfully "marinating" the toughness of the strongholds of their souls. Perhaps at a later date I'll write of some of the insights God has shown me from Scripture explaining why these prayers work so powerfully. Psalm 42:5, Romans 8:6&7 (Amplified) and 2 Corinthians 10:4&5 are some clues.

If you try this personally or recommend that others try this experiment, please don't forget to put this

warning label on your efforts: "If you start praying this prayer, don't stop or you may experience SOULISH BACKLASH resulting in misery. Should this occur, resume praying the *BTP* "page 30 prayer" immediately to relieve symptoms." Forgive me for not writing more. The time grows late and I must get to bed on time so I can wake up with enough time to pray page 30 of *Breaking The Power*. #### DIFFICULT ISSUES #1:

#### FACING REALITY TO EMBRACE TRUTH

(This ministry response is to a man who asked that his question not be posted. This man had left the ministry, pursued a worldly profession, and then rededicated his life to the Lord. Because of consequences from wrong choices while out of fellowship with God, this man had experienced great discouragement and felt completely disillusioned because God was not answering his prayers. He was struggling in his profession, deep in debt, distrusting God, and at his wit's end, even contemplating suicide. He wrote a very poignant, confidential message asking for any reason to have hope at this point in his life. The following is Liberty's response given to him.)

**Dear DGAD:** You have every reason to hope and to lift up your head. I do not say this as an abstract rope to tie a knot in and hang onto, I say this with directions and steps and solutions to offer you. So, please, consider what I have to say. First of all, just as you indicated you believed I would say, your soul is greatly involved here. Your unsundered soul believes that it is doing what is best for you—all the while it is alienating you from God and others, blocking input from God, and heaping great discouragement, depression, and burden upon your existing unmet needs, unhealed hurts, and unresolved issues. **Bad place for you to root down and sink slowly beneath the quicksand!**

You say you just don't trust God any more because He has not answered your prayers. How many times I remember saying that same thing myself in years past. I have been a Christian for 28 years and the first 13 years were awful. I tried to outsmart God, accused Him of being unfaithful to me, and constantly told Him all kinds of negative things. It is only by His pure love and grace and mercy that I wasn't turned into "toast" in those early years of my very bumpy relationship with Him.

You can probably be very, very grateful that God has not answered a lot of your prayers if you were not willing to hear **His answers to them.** He withholds answers that will permit us to stay right in our ever-spiraling downward ruts. Usually those are the answers we want when we feel the most panicky and desperate. I believe that we often pray "great," even highly religious, prayers that we feel list the only possible solutions. Our souls stubbornly conclude this, and if God does not answer accordingly to our willful conclusion, our soul insists that God does not care and cannot be trusted!

All the while, God knows that the answer the soul is seeking will only prolong the pain and put off the true

solution. When God does not give what the soul wants, the soul rejects any other possible divine input. This is called a stand-off! No one ever successfully "stands off" God. Believe me, I know from experience.

You say you have not read my books, and only "perused" my web site. Obviously I feel this is the next step you need to take, but we'll get to that later. Then you say something else that is very interesting: You say you think I will probably blame your soul for the feelings you are experiencing, but this won't help you because you need something concrete to deliver you out of your circumstances right now.

You do need help, but it is not deliverance from your circumstances—**it is "deliverance" from your own unsundered soul's control over your mind, will, and emotions.** You cannot be "delivered" (in the most commonly used Christian understanding of that word) from yourself by any external means of help from others. You have to cut (or "loose") the cords of your soul's bondage over your own life. This is where the most power lies in using the keys of the Kingdom, binding and loosing, in principles of prayer (Matthew 16:19). You are quite educated, and you are obviously intelligent. This is good, but it can also complicate your grasp of how simple this can really be when you are applying the keys of binding and loosing principles to your own life.

I have spent the last fifteen years of my ministry learning about the power of the unsundered soul, while personally living out hard and serious consequences of my own stubborn soul in order to understand God's direction and revelation regarding this message. I have committed all that I have studied, learned, practiced, and seen the fruit of, into the three books that make up what I call the "Keys of the Kingdom Trilogy." There is no practical way here for me to give you three pills and a "call me in the morning" directive. You need to read and then use those three books. In order to do that, you would need to invest approximately \$40.00 in your own life by going to our **order page** and ordering *Shattering Your Strongholds*, *Breaking the Power*, and *Producing the Promise*.

If you choose to not get the books, my good life and destiny purposes won't change a bit. **Neither will yours, most likely.** Why do I think you need to read the books? Because I have written nearly 600 pages about these principles, pages filled with scriptural understanding, anecdotes, examples, Greek and Hebrew word studies, humor, "training wheel" prayers, and hope, all to convince people, and you, just how easy it is to use the keys of the Kingdom to unseat your unsundered soul from the throne of your life. To try to condense that down into something I have time to write here would be like trying to recreate the wheel—an inferior recreation of a fine wheel at that!

I'm not about to blame you personally for anything you are now experiencing, as you have been deceived by the long-entrenched delusions of control out of your own soul. **But there is no reason to stay deceived.** I will tell you, however, that God is the only one you can trust right now—and I believe that my books will give you a means of understanding what God has been and is now trying to tell you through the words of Christ. Victory and success as a Christian will come only through surrender and obedience to God's Word. "Obedience and surrender to God" are fighting words that will immediately cause your unsundered soul to declare an ALL-OUT WAR against anything that will weaken its control over your life. You cannot trust what your own soul will be telling you about not trusting God. That would be like asking a compulsive liar if he was telling you the truth.

I could quote Scriptures at you for twenty minutes about why you have a reason to hope. And I would hope that you know some of them already. If not, then you have neglected your Bible reading. If you try to read the Word and it doesn't mean anything, then it means that your soul is working very hard to accomplish a shut down of that source of help and hope, too. It is all going to keep coming back down to the core of my message: **the human soul is capable of doing anything that it feels will protect its status of running the human life experience.** It is especially capable of building extremely dangerous patterns of thinking and wrong mind sets that will reinforce and protect what it has chosen to believe.

I assure you that your soul is going to now tell you that I have ulterior motives in trying to get you to buy and read these three books. I'm too busy to spend this much time just to try to get you to buy books for any profit motive. I do, however, have an up-front spiritual motive: You are being soundly deceived by a wounded, angry, fearful, unsundered soul that is trying to stay in control of all you think and do. I hate that and I have devoted my life to exposing such to anyone who truly wants to be free.

You say you don't care anymore, that you are completely disillusioned. You do care, or you wouldn't have written to me! I suggest that you go back to my website, particularly to the **Testimonies Page** and then to the **Q&A page**, and read all that is on them. Also, download the last **newsletter** (February 2000, I believe) and read the two stories of the disillusioned and discouraged people who recently wrote the LSM office. Thousands of these kinds of testimonies have been piling up in my ministry files since 1993. If this were a message that could only temporarily delude, promote denial, and give false hope, people would have stopped responding a long time ago.

Some of my most ardent supporters have been using these principles for years to continue to get free from all

of the roots out of their pasts, to open up their unmet needs/unhealed hurts/unresolved issues to God's healing power, and to **stay free** from the misinformation flooding the world today. A strong Christian can only continue to pray enthusiastically, actively, and intelligently with principles that strip away all personal delusion, comfort zones, the self-protection of denial, and all soulish confusion—to produce tangible and irrefutable fruit—when he is convinced of the power of the Word behind those principles. Otherwise he will give up.

**This is not a feel-good message.** These principles take faith, persistence, and sometimes real work to press through to breakthrough. But at least you can know you are using something that works and going somewhere that is **spiritually real and productive and permanent.** This is a necessary thing to know and hang onto when your soul starts kicking up a lot pain and fear as it senses it is losing its grip on your life.

**This is not a prosperity message,** and these principles may require that you obey God and give up everything you have acquired to start over on a **sure path to victory.** No one presses into this message for purposes of a little relief or a little blessing. They press into it because they are sick and tired of being sick and tired! I promise this, however, it is a message that can help you cut out the junk messing up your decision-making ability. This is a message that will clear your prayer lines to God and get you into a place where you will hear His voice. The choice is yours. Rev. Liberty Savard

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### DIFFICULT ISSUES #2: SO YOU THINK YOU'RE CALLED TO BE A PROPHET?

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Dear PTB: Since you say you are praying the binding and loosing prayers (I am assuming from *Shattering Your Strongholds*), I will try to answer your questions that are really somewhat out of the format that this Q&A page was intended to provide. It was intended for questions regarding use of these principles. I will try to address, quite directly and truthfully, your questions below. If you feel offended or angry at anything I say, please stop and pray the binding and loosing prayers immediately to bring your soul into whatever submission to God's will that you can. You have asked me to speak into your life, which I am honored to do. I will speak carefully from what I believe is the truth of God. Know that anger, defensiveness, hurt feelings, and offense are reactions out of the soul, they are never from the born again spirit.

**Rev. Savard, I haven't been a Christian for long, maybe a little over a year and I've backslid once already. Several months ago I became a member at my church and I am really loving the Lord and all that He has done and is doing and going to do in my**

**life. I've asked God to reveal to me my calling and He has. I'm a prophet and soon to pastor or maybe just preach in my own ministry. The Lord has led me to scriptures with the warning of being deceived and about false prophets coming up. I'm a little confused as to whether or not God was telling me that I was a false prophet or if I should beware of false prophets?**

I'm pleased you are aware of the possibility of being deceived. Good for you. The danger is not so much in whether or not you might be a false prophet, as it is in whether or not you might be a "baby" prophet-yet-in-training who is giving false prophecies. Both **1) prophets with unsundered souls and hardened hearts, and 2) immature "baby" prophets-in-training with unsundered souls and tender hearts** can "prophesy" false prophecies. What is the common factor here? **THE UNSUNDERED SOUL.**

**I've already applied the scriptures that He led me to to myself, but I still get alot of prophetic words and revelations. I'm aware that just because one gets revelation or prophecies, that doesn't necessarily mean that they are a prophet.**

God has said in many places in the Scriptures that a prophet will be known or judged to be a true prophet if the words of the prophet come to pass. Two of these verses are Jer. 28:9, "*The prophet which prophesieth of peace, when the word of the prophet shall come to pass, then shall the prophet be known, that the LORD hath truly sent him*" (KJV), and Eze. 33:33, "*And when this cometh to pass, (lo, it will come,) then shall they know that a prophet hath been among them*" (KJV). In other words, the coming to pass of the words prophesied is the true test of ANY prophet's words.

You need to have a strong inner foundation of the Word to recognize subtle deceptions from your unsundered soul or the devil. To be a true prophet of the Lord requires a surrendered and submitted soul, and a fixed commitment to wanting only the will of God to be done. This is exactly the goal of the binding and loosing prayer principles, that only God's will is wanted.

I would encourage you to read and reread the book of Jeremiah. This book, perhaps more than any other (in my estimation) shows how God feels about the difference between a true prophet and those who prophesy out of their own souls. To prophesy words that are not given by God is a very, very dangerous thing. To prophesy out of your own soul not only places you in a dangerous place, it places the one you have prophesied to into the same dangerous place if they come into agreement with your soulish prophecy. Why would anyone? Because words can make a person feel good and also perceive personal benefit from believing that the "word" must be true.

**Also, I believe that the Lord led me to leave my job to be available for Him full-time and the Lord has been preparing me for something, maybe that ministry.**

The Lord often trains His people and teaches them discipline and order by having them submit to the routine of jobs and daily responsibilities. He wants you already on the path of discipline and obedience by the time you need to move in it during a ministry assignment He gives to you. He will very clearly open and close doors to verify His desires for change of such a work status in your life.

**I shared this same information with my Pastor who is also a prophet. I've been inspired by the Holy Spirit to write several sermons and I shared one of them with my Pastor and he said the "sermon" I shared would be a nice book to minister to people with. I agree, but I also believe that it is a sermon to be preached.**

A pastor must be very careful of who he or she allows to preach in the pulpit of the flock he or she has been given to shepherd. If God has a message for you to preach, when you are ready to preach that message, nothing will hold back God's favor to open that door for you. If you are to preach in this pastor's pulpit, God will arrange the favor and the timing. This is not something for you to try to arrange or manipulate.

**Our church has just completed a time of dedication and worship, and I was constantly on the floor (exhibiting a physical manifestation), sometimes a lot. I also do the same thing sometimes during praising the Lord. I know I have physically "affected" other people with this (manifestation) accidentally. My Pastor asked me, "Did you get revelation as to why you would be (exhibiting this manifestation)"? I know there was some sarcasm in his question because I told him about some of the revelations God had given me.**

Your last statement here is not only a criticism and a judgment of one of God's spiritual leaders, it is also a word curse that can backlash on you as well as being destructive to the leader if you verbalize it to other people. Your soul wants it to be true in order to justify and validate its "need" to believe that your pastor is in error in not accepting and validating what you believe to be true. You may well be a potential prophet, but God uses people in authority over us to hold us in a state of training and learning until we are ready to be used. This is God's doing, not necessarily the doing of the authority figures. Can these authority figures have wrong motives? Yes, they certainly can. But God will not allow you to be held back from your destiny because of someone else's wrong motives. **He will, however, allow you to be trained and matured through learning how to react spiritually to those wrong motives of others.** The only thing that can hold you back is your own soul.

Just read about Joseph being locked in prison for something he had not done, and know that God never

wastes anything in our lives (no matter how negative it may seem to us and others around us at the time). I am quite sure that God used that time of imprisonment to teach Joseph to surrender to the greater purpose yet to come. God was setting him up to become a powerful influence in a foreign culture in order to make a way for his own family to be saved in a time of great famine.

So often we pitch a soulish "fit" when God puts us into hard places. That hard place may be His process to put us into positions of great authority to fulfill plans so great we cannot comprehend them. We pitch a "fit" and abort God's plans, and then we have to go back to the "school of hard places" for more remedial training.

God so prepared Joseph that he held no hard feelings or offenses against his brothers (rascals that they were). Genesis 50:20 says that Joseph said this to his brothers who had deeply wronged him, even to the putting of his life in mortal danger, *"But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive"* (KJV).

Galatians 4:1-2 tells us this: *"The heir (this could also be a baby prophet, or baby pastor, or baby apostle), as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; but is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father"* (KJV). When one is a prophet-yet-in-training, regardless of the incredible potential of that young "master," he or she must be tutored and governed, sometimes even contained, by those with more experience and understanding until the Father appoints that one as being ready. The appointing is in the hands of the Father, never in the hands of the tutors or governors. Don't worry about opportunities to fulfill your destiny once you reach the point where God can begin to move you into them. No one can open or shut a door that God sets in place.

**Rev. Savard, do you think I should continue to believe that I am one of God's prophets?**

You obviously want to be used by God. This is a good thing, and I commend you for wanting to cooperate with God in this calling. However, I heard a missionary say when God called him to the Philippines, he sold everything he had, quit his job, and was ready to go—but God did not send him until 13 years later! He had heard the call of God correctly, but he didn't understand the concept of being prepared to fulfill it. There is often an unknown time for training and maturing **between the call and the going forth to fulfill it**. What most affects the length of that unknown passage of time? The individual's ability to submit themselves to obedience and learning and maturing in the purposes of the call.

**I don't want to continue to say the Lord sent me or the Lord said, if indeed He didn't. So I'm getting a little unsure at this point. What do you think about the sermons, me being a pastor, the purging and my**

**Pastor's response to all of this? Please help me and most of all please pray for me. Please bind me and loose what you think and believe may need to be loosed and bound. Rev. Savard, I trust you and the decisions you make.**

I do not want to discourage you in any way, as you may well be one of the greatest end times prophets God is now raising up. But you do need further experience with God, particularly in allowing Him to train you in the use of His gifts. This is not a caution that you must sit and wait for 13 years, rather this is a call to you to redirect your energies into preparation for being used. Read, read, and reread the book of Jeremiah along with as much other Scripture as you can make time to read.

Read about all of the Old Testament prophets and learn from them. One final word of caution, from my own experience and my own beliefs. Prophecy is being misused and abused these days. So-called prophets are prophesying out of their own souls that which they believe people want to hear, also that which the so-called prophets believe validates what they choose to believe about certain churches, ministries, and individuals.

One good word for you to always think about: If you already have strong feelings about an individual or a ministry needing correction and then you believe God has given you a prophecy that validates exactly what you have been already thinking, **it is almost always a false prophecy coming out of your soul**. The prophetic words I trust the most are the words a prophet gives that are nearly as surprising to the prophet as to the one being prophesied to. I hope this helps. Rev. Liberty Savard

#### **Follow-up Response by E-Mail the Next Day**

**Hi Rev. Savard. I thank you for your timely response and most of all, I thank you for your honesty. I was not offended by any of it. Regarding the part of your response, "The danger is not so much in whether or not you might be a false prophet, as it is in whether or not you might be a "baby" prophet-yet-in-training who is giving false prophecies," how do I know? Quite a few of my "prophecies" have been confirmed and have come to pass, but I understand that the devil can give confirmation and make "prophecies" come to pass also, is this correct? How do I know the source behind it being confirmed and/or coming to pass?**

The devil does not "make" prophecies come to pass, rather he sets up the unsundered soul to "think" a "prophecy" prior to his causing something to happen. He does the same thing when he is aware of other things coming to pass even though he has nothing to do with them. I do not think Satan can read your mind, nor do I think he can foretell the future. He simply is aware of things already in progress (things that the finite minds of humans have no way of knowing until they actually happen) and pre-determines how he can take advantage

of them. He does this by implanting suggestions into the mind through access into unsundered souls that cannot discern his intervention or interference. These doors of access into the unsundered human soul are explained in detail in *Shattering Your Strongholds*.

Knowing who or what is the source of something coming to pass is where the spiritual gift (nine spiritual gifts in 1 Corinthians 12:7-11) of Discerning of Spirits comes into use. This is NOT the gift of discernment as some think it is—a "gift" that can be used to discern anything you want. It is a spiritual gift given by the Holy Ghost to know what is behind a supernatural happening, including the seeming fulfillment of prophecy. It is the gifting to know if an evil spirit, the Holy Spirit, or the soul of a man or woman is involved. This is something everyone needs to understand. A Christian whose unsundered soul can be accessed and confused by the enemy can "fall for" a counterfeit work or manifestation that only appears to be of God.

**I surrender my unsundered soul to the will of God, I pull down, smash, crush and destroy any and all strongholds in my soul that I've erected to protect any wrong beliefs, attitudes, behavior, thinking, thoughts, thoughts patterns, wrong relationships, wrong agreements and I loose any and all effects that have come out of those aforementioned things...did I do right? If so, did I leave anything out? Please help me!**

Yes, you are right on, with the possible exception of adding loosing soul ties. Have you read my second and third books, *Breaking the Power* and/or *Producing the Promise*? Each one has a chapter on soul power/soul ties. This would be good information for you to read. *Producing the Promise* has a chapter on the power of agreement that will give you further understanding.

**As for the book of Jeremiah, the Holy Spirit has led me to this book and I have read it several times. He also led me to the book of Job, Isaiah, Micah, Lamentations and Ezekiel which I have read, but I will reread them and continue to do so until I come into full understanding or wherever I should be with these books. As for me leaving my job, I may have done so in haste and I asked God to forgive me for moving in my time if indeed He did not tell me to move at that time. But I do know that God is training me and teaching me discipline and order**

Good for you. Now, know this: we can be aware of something being taught to us or being worked out in our life, but we still need to go "through" the experience of it. This can take some time and some maturing. For an example, when we are younger we can understand that we are maturing physically, yet we still have to go through the actual growing process to become physically mature. Knowing you are in training does not complete the process of going through the training. Being in

training and learning order and discipline is where you want to be cooperating with God as freely and purely as possible. This is where the principles of praying the binding and loosing prayers help to clear out the unusable humanistic and worldly clutter our "pack rat" minds have accumulated that can cause missteps and misdirection in our best of intentions.

**As for the (physical manifestation) or "purging" portion of my question, I do understand that may not be of God, but I didn't know at the time and I never meant to do it. I truly thought and believed that this was a "purging process".**

I understand what you are saying. I wasn't criticizing you, I was saying that you should not feel any condemnation from what you may have already done in this manner. I was encouraging you that it was time to seek God and ask for revelation and confirmation in the Word for understanding from now on. Everyone makes mistakes, and ministers in training make a lot of them. I heard a Bible teacher once say: If you aren't making some mistakes, you aren't taking enough risks in trying to implement what you are learning. I concur!

**Regarding my stating "I knew there was some sarcasm there because I told him about some of the revelations God had given me," I truly meant no disrespect to my pastor, God or you . . . I am sorry if I indicated that I by any chance was criticizing and/or judging my pastor. I may have criticized and/or judged him, but it was not intentional and may God forgive me and have mercy on my soul, in Jesus name I pray. Amen. Thank you Lord.**

He absolutely will and so do I! However, I still think there is something important here to be learned. You say you are sorry if you indicated that by any chance you were criticizing or judging your pastor. Please hear me, for this is something extremely important. Whether you meant to indicate it or not, whether it was intentional or not, you did speak judgment and criticism of his response to you. Recognize that your soul is trying to rationalize your intentions behind what you said. If you can recognize this, you can stop it next time. Please know that I am not trying to hammer the fact of the words you said. That's been cleared by your repentance. I'm trying to get you to realize that this can be a very subtle area. If you can get that understanding now, you can save yourself a great deal of trouble later on. I had to learn it the hard way, and I am still living with the fall-out from situations years ago where I spoke judgment over other ministers and ministries. Having to live with this fall-out helps me to understand the importance of not creating it in the first place. We can repent and turn away from what we have done and still find "consequences" like weeds in our paths for some time. It is better to learn how

not to "sow" those weedy consequences. That, my friend, is a life long project.

Many (more like most) Christians do not realize the power their words produce to bless or condemn—themselves and/or others. That is why we are urged in the New Testament to not even jest. The word jest/jesting in the original Greek covers a range from being facetious (which means clever, foolish, sarcastic, joking) all the way to being scurrilous (which means offensive, insulting, reproachful, insolent, obscene). One way to judge your words' intent is to ask yourself would you be willing to go to the person you said something about and tell them exactly what you had said? This reality check can rob your unsundered soul of its ability to tell you that you really didn't mean anything wrong.

When we say we are just "kidding" or just "joking" or "didn't mean it," this is often an attempt to soften a less-than-kind point we really do want to make but we hope we cannot be held accountable for making. (I know that you were not attempting to do what I am going to say next, but this is a good thing to realize and understand.) Even worse, saying we are just "kidding" or just "joking" or "didn't mean it" is often an attempt to transfer "blame" by accusing the other person of not having a sense of humor, of being too sensitive, or of deliberately misunderstanding what we have said. Our spoken words have enormous power, regardless of a malicious or innocent intent in speaking them—power that can open doors of access to works of the enemy.

I sometimes struggle with speaking with sarcastic humor when I think the other person can relate or understand. A spiritual leader must never excuse his or her words by whether or not another person has misunderstood them! A spiritual leader must be held accountable for any words that give Satan room to mess around with them and hurt another person.

We have to constantly watch what we say about others, for we can easily judge wrongly. This is part of the society we live in. Everyone in the world today seems to have an opinion about everything and everyone else. Christians, especially Christian leaders (in training or otherwise) must learn to be aware of this.

**You have answered all my questions and have been a lot of help and once again, I thank you for your timely response and your honesty.**

And blessings back to you. I sense that you have a very dynamic future ahead of you. Rev. Savard

### DIFFICULT ISSUES #3:

#### **SOULISH PRAYERS ARE DANGEROUS!**

**QUESTION:** My daughter met a man she felt was the man God wanted her to marry. A friend of mine and I prayed, and after having visions about them marrying, we felt this was God's will. My daughter and I prayed

together with much fervency about this, especially after a prophetic word from a minister that seemed to confirm what we were praying. We heard preaching that even if what you are believing to get from God looks impossible, don't give up. The young man has now walked away from God and gone into many wrong choices, marrying another woman. My daughter and I are devastated. I am certain he knew that my daughter was chosen of God for him, but he rebelled. Did I pray wrong?

**ANSWER:** I hope you have written to ask me this with an expectation of truth in my reply. You have indeed prayed wrong, and thereby helped your daughter to believe in something that appears to have had nothing to do with God. To be very blunt, you prayed soulish prayers with your friend and you prayed soulish prayers with your daughter. The best thing to have prayed was to bind your daughter to the will and purposes of God for her life. I think the next thing is for you to repent to God of trying to get what you and your daughter wanted, and then ask Him to forgive you both. He will. It would also be a good thing to discuss this with your daughter and ask her to forgive you, as well. Then both of you should forgive this young man and bind him to God's will and release him. Let God work out His plans for his life.

Then I would suggest that you immediately get a copy of the Preparing for a Mate Prayer Chart from our Resource Order Page (on the website), or if you have a copy of *Producing the Promise*, the same prayer is in that book. Begin to encourage your daughter to pray that prayer, and agree with her in the praying of it. Because of the soulish prayers that have been prayed, I would encourage you to get both *Breaking the Power* and *Producing the Promise* and read the chapters and the prayers in them on Soul Power and Breaking Soul Ties. Wrong agreements (especially in prayer) over things that never were God's plans always cause soul ties to be formed between the people coming into the wrong agreements. You will know how to pray and how to help your daughter pray so that she is freed from emotional entanglements and expectations of this young man.

**QUESTION:** Why did we have these visions, why were they confirmed by a minister who didn't know us, and why do we still feel this man is the one?

**ANSWER:** Because people were praying soulish prayers, rather than praying that God's will would be done in each life, regardless of how He was going to shake out the details. I can see your heart's love for your daughter, but your "heart" wants what you think would be best for your daughter. The heart, or the soul when left to its own devices (remember "heart" is often translated from the Greek or Hebrew words for the soul: the mind, the will, and the emotions) rarely wants what God wants and knows is best for all the people involved in any situation. I hope you are not offended by the

bluntness of my honesty. But you have a chance here to see a real miraculous work of God cleaning up the attempts of the enemy to capitalize on soulish prayers.

Your "job" is to see that the effects and influences of those wrong agreements are broken by loosing them. In other words, pray this: "I loose all of the effects and influences of the wrong agreements that I have made, and any resulting soul ties that have been formed from them. Remember that loosing in the Greek means smash, crush, shatter, tear up, and tear apart. Last night we prayed for you and your daughter. God is ready to put everything back on track with His will.
